This car was found in Fort Bragg, California in 1982. It was rusting under a dangerously leaning shed at the end of a half mile long dirt road. It was a 200ci six cylinder rolling total with 125,000 hard miles on it. It took eighteen months to get the car back on the road.

Throughout the years the car has undergone some changes. In 1998, it went from Stock to Supercharged. This car was definitely a street sleeper and won the respect of others at Firebird when it finally reached the thirteen second quarter mile goal. Not too bad for 3300 pounds of American heavy metal! In 2004, the Mustang was tamed so that it could once again be a cruising car. Dan Martorano and his crew dropped in a punched out 302 with modified heads and long tube headers, a modified C4 transmission and a 600 CSM Edelbrock carburetor. Although the track days are over, this car can still turn heads as it muscled down the road. There are always offers to buy the car, but this one is, and always will be, a part of the family.
